4151/21/FUL: South Efford House, Aveton Gifford, TQ7 4NX

Proposed demolition of care home and replacement of 6 Residential Dwellings

2044/21/FUL: Wave Hill Farm, Loddiswell, TQ7 4EG

Temporary rural worker's dwelling shelter, compost toilet and change of use of 475 m² to a mix of agriculture and seasonal tourism. Extension of farm yard to east and realignment of hedge. Shepherd's hut with porch link to caravan for ancillary accommodation.
